BV Dulcet '05 Cabernet, Syrah Napa Valley
Aromas of ripe fruit, dark currant with hints of mocha and vanilla with a firm well integrated finish. em

Leatherwood '06 Shiraz, Viognier South Africa
Complex, exciting spicy wine enhanced by dry apricot flavors tws

2006 Saddlerock Cabernet Sauvignon The seductive 2006 Saddlerock Cabernet will awaken your senses with its subtle balance of cherry, vanilla, and a touch of nutmeg. The perfect wine, from day to night to candlelight.

Crios '07 Malbec, Argentina. Black raspberry and dark chocolate on the nose, sappy and primary with inky cassis, blackberry and licorice flavors complicated by a hint of cocoa. td

Clancy's Blend '05 Shiraz, Cabernet/ Merlot, Australia. Peter Lehman has earned its status as an Australian Legend and continues this tradition with a bouquet of ripe plums with a hint of dusted chocolate, full berry characters and an elegantly understated oak component. emp

Bridgeview Pinot Noir '07, Oregon, U.S.
This rich and luscious Pinot Noir is highlighted by bright flavors of cherry and strawberry and complimented by soft nuances of oak. td

Saddlerock '05 Merlot, California 2008 Silver Medal winner at the Monterey Wine Competition. Beyond the elegant smoky nose that hints at fine tobacco, cedar and pepper, you'll discover an undertone of sweet berry and fig. The 2005 Saddlerock Merlot is fashionable on any table and a superb partner to any meal. emp

Cotes du Ventoux '07 Red Rhone, France
Syrah, Cinsault and Grenache grapes from 40 year old vines blended. td

Haut-Medoc '05 Bordeaux, France - \$36/bottle
Unoaked, fruit-forward red (blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon) with flavors of cassis and cherry. td

Leflaive '06 Bourgogne, France - \$45/bottle
100% Pinot Noir with medium color and body that is soft, round, juicy and succulent. Earthy with concentrated yet structured wild berry notes. td

Righetti Amarone '05 Morano, Italy - \$55/bottle
A traditional blend of Corvina, Rondinella, and Molinara made in the passito method in which the grapes are spread on straw mats and permitted to dry for up to three months before crushing, then aged in oak for two years, giving it an intense bouquet and flavor. Dried fruit, almonds, and anise with a smooth finish and lingering aftertaste. Truly a special wine! td

❖ RED WINES \$6.00 SELECTIONS ❖

Domaine Antugnac '07 Pinot Noire, Languedoc, France "One of the best Pinot Noir values on the market" by Robert Parker, and it is ripe with notes of Bing Cherry, raspberry, earth, exotic spice. cv

Gougenheim '07 Malbec Mendoza This "extreme value" is rich, open knit, displaying juicy notes of cherry, plum, spice, and mocha. cv

L' Abbaye de St. Ferme '04 Bordeaux blend, France. A delicious example of a classic Bordeaux, estate bottled and aged in french oak barrels, flavors of sweet black cherries and chocolate. emp

Garnacha de Fuego '07 Garnacha, Spain
In the mouth, there is a rush of dark fruit with an underlying bright spice. This is full-bodied, but still lively, with rounded tannins which combine with the fruit to produce an exotic spicy finish. td

Four Vines Zinfandel '07 "Old Vine Cuvee" California - This isn't a "shy wine" whatsoever.....it's all about big, jammy blueberry and blackberry with subtle flavors of peppery spice and vanilla. cv

Peirano Estate '07 Six Clones Merlot, California produced from 6 different clones, or sub-varieties, of Merlot grown on the estate. It leads with aromas of currant, cranberry and violet, with hints of toast, coffee and vanilla. td

Monte Antico Rosso '05, Tuscany, Italy
This Super-Tuscan is a blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet, and Merlot and has aromas of black cherries, licorice and plums. On the palate this wine displays flavors of ripe red fruits, with subtle notes of vanilla and its soft tannins give this wine a silky texture. td
Line 39 Cabernet Sauvignon '06, California
"With neighbors like Napa and Sonoma counties, Lake County grapes are perfect for my style of Cabernet Sauvignon. td

Acacia '07 Chardonnay Carneros

With aromas of apple, mango, fig and guava this medium to full-bodied palate maintains impressive balance and flavor concentration, so it will hold its own with rich foods. The flavors of tropical and ripe stone fruits complement its acidity, and the finish is rich and long. td

Monmousseau Vouvray '07 France A dry to soft wine from the heart of the central Loire Valley. td

A to Z '07 Pinot Gris Oregon, A medium to full bodied white wine packed with ripe notes of nectarine, peach, melon, and honey. It is the ideal wine to serve with fish. Wine Enthusiast called it “one of Oregon’s top white wine values”. 89 points cv

Rockhouse Native Yeast, '06 Chardonnay, Tryon, North Carolina. Crisp and refreshing with notes of pear, apple and melon with a smooth finish. td

Beaulieu Vineyard (BV) Carneros Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California Lush aromas and flavors of citrus blossom and peach infused with hints vanilla cream and nutmeg. The palate offers bright fruit flavors with rich texture and a long, silky finish. emp

Cono Sur '08 Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough - Clean and crisp, with aromas and flavors suggesting grapefruit, lemon/lime, and green apple. cv

Barton & Guestier Vouvray '07 100% Chenin Blanc, France. Zesty wine with notes of stone fruit backed with minerality. emp

Four Vines '07 Chardonnay “Naked” Santa Barbara, California. This wine sees no oak, and is all the better for it.....it is bright, rich, and packed with pineapple, guava, and pear flavors. cv

2 Brothers Riesling '06 Germany

This wine packs vibrant floral and stone fruit aromas, joined in the mouth by concentrating flavors of citrus, apple and hints of melon, wrapped up in the lingering finish accented by honeydew and stone.

Valckenberg Madonna Kabinett Riesling, Alsace This Riesling is drier & lighter in style, and showcases an intense floral bouquet with an underlying herbal character. Bright flavors of peaches and apricots are displayed on the palate. td

Cielo '07 Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie - Bright and crisp, with green apple, pear, citrus aromas and flavors. It is thirst-quenching. cv

Mapema '07, Sauvignon Blanc, Mendoza, Argentina. Medium bodied and a round style with a slight fig character
